### **LARGO-KETTERING LIBRARY OFFERS LIMITED SERVICE DURING RENOVATION**

*Hyattsville, Md.*— In late January contractors will begin a renovation of the Largo-Kettering Branch of the Prince George's County Memorial Library System. The branch will be closed to the public on Monday and Tuesday, January 26 and 27. The branch will reopen with limited service on Wednesday, January 28. The project will be completed by June 30, 2009.

During the renovation, there will be limited service in the lobby and meeting room. Please note that:

- there will be a small selection of new materials, DVDs, basic reference and children's books
- due to limited space there will be very little seating
- a small number of public computers will be available for internet access or word processing
- items may be returned and reserved items will be available for pick-up
- the copier will be available
